*Never stop* moving to claim the " \_\_\_\_\_ ", trusting the Lord to help you \_\_\_\_\_ the giants. (14:12-14)

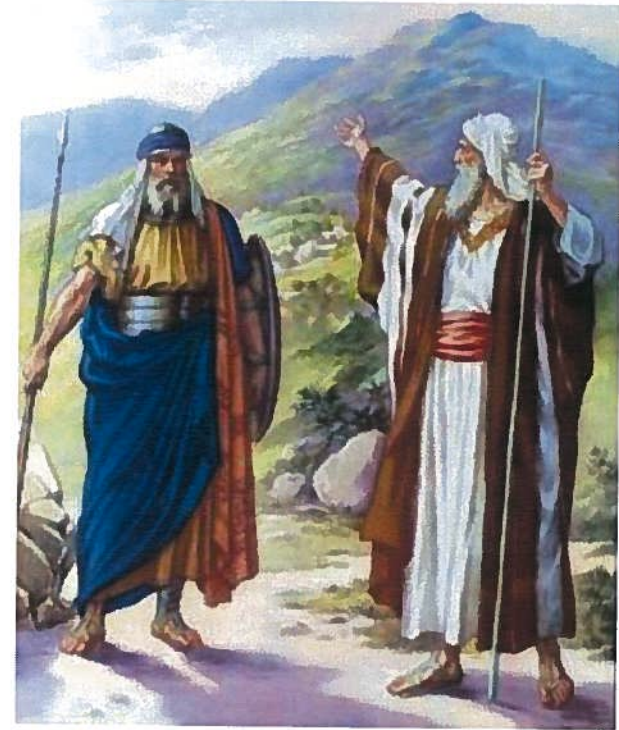

It's been a wild and wonderful week around here! Some 280 kids invaded the "Bayou" here at Crocodile Dock. They've learned what a POWERFUL GOD they have, so they need not *fear*! I have no doubt that many young lives were changed here

at KCC this past week for time and eternity. I'm so grateful for the dedicated effort of our Directors (Pastor Marie and Sandy Simmons) and for SO MANY wonderful volunteers! So many of you prayed, donated goodies, decorated, taught, cooked, served as group leaders, parked cars, etc, etc. What a team effort! The Lord was honored as these children came to trust Him, some for the very first time. Thank you for your partnership for the children and for the Kingdom!

**Jack & Mahi Snell will be with us this coming weekend!** Jack & Mahi have served as missionaries in China for 20 years. They'll be enrolling sons Christopher and Jeremy in the University of Hawaii and the University of Alabama respectively in the coming weeks. They've returned for a period to the Big Island, where Mahi's parents live, as they're in need of much care at this stage of life. **Jack will preach all 3 weekend services from Joshua. I've had a sneak peek at where he's going with chapters 15-19 and you're going to be moved by this message!**

**We're seriously considering a Holy Land Pilgrimage and Mission Trip in the fall of 2010.** Just as we did in 2008, we'd return to Jordan to minister to Iraqi refugees through Global Hope and we'd go to "our village" of Muftradat in the north of Jordan to continue to serve these Muslim peoples with Jesus' love. We've provided food and goats, and others are continuing this work. Inroads *are* being made for the Gospel! And Israel...wow!
